## THIS IS HOW YOU REGISTER

Our registration forms are available from the Play Centre room and school office, you can also go on our website.

All children must have a completed form to attend Breakfast Club /Play Centre.

All parents are welcome to visit the play room before registering their child/children which will give you the opportunity to see our staff in action!

Fees are £12 a session

If you are on a low income please talk to Denise about a subsidized fee.

Included in the fee is evening tea which allows your child to converse with their peers over a snack in a relaxed atmosphere



## BREAKFAST CLUB

Our breakfast club is free thanks to the generosity of Greggs Bakery.

We serve a variety of different food for the children.

This service is available from

8.00am until 8.50am.

However children must arrive before 8.30am to receive breakfast.

## Play Centre's S.O.P's

At Play Centre we have our standard operating procedures they outline the day to day running of the Centre.

Play Centre runs from 3.30—6.00pm

We must run at ratios of 1:8 under 8's.

We can only register 24 per session
